You can do all 5 in 3 hours by automobile. You could do by bike or hiking starting at the winter parking lot. About a 10 mile loop.

**Winter Parking Lot** at HPSP West Side of Park. N 41 18.463 W 074 40.864

Remember some of these roads are closed in the winter to automobile traffic.

Head down Ridge Road on the right

Geocache 1 pull off parking: N 41 18.728 W 074 41.426

Elevation: 1388

**GEOCACHE 1 Awesome Force** (hint- 50 yards past gate, head east)

N 41 18.882 W 074 41.424

Elevation: 1325

Road closed in winter can get close with snowmobile, horse, snowshoe, Ski or walking.

No more than 50 yards off trail. I placed a travel bug in this one from Oklahoma

Head down Ridge Rd. on the right

Geocache 2 pull off parking: N 41 18. 314 W 74 42. 362

**GEOCACHE 2 Surprise** (Hint: Follow Rock Wall)

N 41 18.318 W 074 42.444

Elevation 1218

Road closed in winter can get close with snowmobile, horse, snowshoe, Ski or walking.

No more than 50 yards off trail.

Travel bug with Hitch hiker: 42P1WK, wants to get to a Technology Ed program in

Wantage, England

Head down Ridge Rd, on the Right park on left.

Geocache 3 pull off parking: N 41 17.927 W 74 42.540

**GEOCACHE 3 Sticks and Stones** (Hint: near boulder)

N 41. 17. 858 W 074. 42. 561

Elevation 1209

Road closed in winter can get close with snowmobile, horse, snowshoe, Ski or walking.  
No more than 50 yards off Ridge Rd.

Head down Ridge Rd. take right on Sawmill Lake Rd.

Geocache 4 pull off parking: N 41 15. 488 W 074 42.363

**GEOCACHE 4 CAMO AMMO** (Hint: under rocks)

N 41 15. 483 W 074 42. 323

No More than 50 yards off Saw Mill Lake Rd. Elevation: 1073

Head back up Sawmill Lake Rd. towards winter parking lot

Geocache 5 pull off parking N 41 17. 339 W 074 41. 447

**GEOCACHE 5 SPLITTING WOOD** (Hint: On rock, covered by rocks)

N 41° 17.296 W 074° 41.397

Elevation: 1315

Road closed in winter can get close with snowmobile, horse, snowshoe, Ski or walking.  
No more than 50 yards off Saw Mill Lake Rd., near Deckertown Tpk.

Travel bug started here: GSZHPV, wants to get to a Technology Ed. class in every state.

Continue on Saw Mill Lake Rd. Take a Left on Ridge Road and you are back at the winter parking lot.
